Any act provided for in the law or these Regulations where the offender uses violence, threats or in any way opposes the performance of inspection	Amount of the fine plus 60%
Any act provided for in the law and these Regulations when it is committed against species of flora and fauna that are rare or in danger of extinction or whose exploitation is prohibited	1.000.000.000,00 MT
Any act provided for in the law and these Regulations where the offenders are an organised group	Amount of the fine plus 40%
Any act provided for in the law and these Regulations when the culprit is a first offender	Reduction of the fine by 20%
Any act provided for in the law and these Regulations when the offender has spontaneously sought forest and wildlife inspectors to make good the damage caused voluntarily.	Reduction of the fine by 30%
Any act provided for in the law and these Regulations where the offender has no knowledge or notion of the consequences of the act committed, taking into consideration the offender's background, level of education, social and economic conditions, regional habits and place of residence	Reduction of the fine by 40%
